3. Include any attachments such as photographs, charts, newspaper articles, etc. (These are in addition to the application narratives.)
4. When applying make sure to include a disk with **High Quality Digital Photos**. Digital files will only be accepted at 300 dpi; Adobe pdf, jpg, tiff or eps. These photos may be used for the Awards presentation at the 2012 Winter Convention.
