Please note! Any Company can choose to apply for any or all of the award categories. Each application area will be judged on its own merits and will not be influenced by the number of awards for which a company applies. Awards may not be presented in every category. Projects must have been completed in last two years (January 2009 - current). Projects previously entered into this awards program will NOT be considered. Applicants must operate in Montana.

Application Procedures:

1. Complete the application form in this brochure and please include with it narrative descriptions not to exceed 350 words for each of the criteria, typewritten to the criteria for your particular category. Please make reference to each criteria heading in your response. Please make sure that each one of the bullet points is a heading in your report. Any necessary documentation should be included as attachments to this application.
2. In addition to the criteria, please provide an overall narrative NOT to exceed 350 words focusing on the advantages of using ready mixed concrete, such as durability, sustainability, economy, constructability, lifecycle benefits, project aesthetics, compatibility with project environment, etc. Applicants can apply for as many awards as desired.
3. Include one set of photographs: 6 (minimum) - 10 (maximum) High quality digital photos.
4. When applying make sure to include a disk with **high quality digital photos** (these will be displayed during the MCA annual convention and awards ceremonies).

Judging:

Representatives of various organizations/agencies with concrete expertise will serve as judges. The judging committee reserves the right to make the final decision on all awards. Awards may not be presented in every category. Applicants must operate in Montana.

In the back of the packet, you may include a section for all other information that you would like to be considered when being judged for the award. For the order of each award just continue to read this handout. Please note: we received several comments from judges stating that several submissions were not in accordance with this packet, and were more difficult to judge.

Deadlines:

Applications must be postmarked by November 12, 2010. Awards will be announced and presented at the Annual Convention in Helena, Montana, January 12-14, 2011.

Finalists will be notified by R.S.V.P. invitation to attend the MCA Awards Banquet, January 13, 2011. The winners in each category will be held confidential until the Awards Dinner. All entrants are cordially invited to attend the 2010 Awards Dinner.

3. Difficulties of the project/uniqueness
4. Unique safety challenges on the jobsite and the methods utilized to remedy the issues.
5. Finished quality of the project – most improved
6. Best use of concrete
7. Quality/durability
8. Project design
9. Concrete techniques
10. Outstanding features of the project
11. Pictures of the project (Must include: before, scope of job, companies at work and completed project pictures)
