CITY OF BILLINGS PARK II

Located in the heart of downtown, the Billings Park II Parking Garage was designed with a drive-through lease space on the ground level. The northeast elevator tower blends the design of the adjacent curtain wall and steel panel building with the existing parking garage of pre-cast concrete. The multi-colored patterned concrete on the raised public plaza at the southwest corner of the existing parking structure and the streetscape provides a pedestrian friendly area to gather, have lunch, or just a break from work.

JERRY BOWSER HELENA SAND & GRAVEL, HELENA



Jerry Bowser has been employed with Helena Sand & Gravel, since April 2002, as a manager of the Materials Division, until he accepted his current position as the Environmental and Quality Control Manager for the Montana Companies. Prior to embarking on his career with HSG, Jerry was employed at the Helena office of a regional consulting engineering, environmental, and materials testing firm since

his 1975 graduation from MSU (GO CATS!), in Construction Engineering Technology. He was registered as a Professional Civil Engineer in 1982. Since he has been employed at HSG, he has been instrumental in the success of concrete placed for

the Canyon Ferry Dam Outlet Reconstruction project where the concrete was required to be placed underwater and achieve 14,000 psi. In addition, Jerry was part of a group of MCA industrial professionals that assisted the Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) in initiating, reviewing, revising and implementing the specifications for high performance special deck (HPSD) concrete for bridges/overpasses being constructed in our State. HSG, with Jerry's involvement, volunteered to use the I-15, South Helena Interchange Project as the test project for MDT's new HPSD specification. Jerry has been very actively involved with numerous MCA activities, with the Concrete Division and the Sand & Gravel Committee. He serves on the education, scholarships & ACI subcommittees of the Concrete Division, and has served as the Division Chairman since 2007. He also served as the Chairmen of the Sand & Gravel Committee since its inception in mid-2006.
