- Provide a completed application that demonstrates dedication to scholastic record and ability, involvement in extra-curricular activities, and desire to work hard to succeed.

To qualify for the MCA Concrete Division Scholarships, applicants must:

 Meet the qualifications mentioned above AND be the child or dependent of a member of the MCA's Concrete Division.

To qualify for an MCA Education Foundation Construction Trades Scholarship, applicants must:

- Be attending a construction trades program, or planning to attend a construction trades program.
- Provide a completed application that demonstrates a passion for careers in construction, and the ability to succeed in the construction field.
- Applicants DO NOT need to be affiliated with a MCA member company.

The number of scholarships distributed annually depends on funds raised throughout the year and the quality of applicant pools for the scholarships.
